

PRIVACY POLICY

for M&MR Trading Polska Sp. z o.o. websites

1. General provisions

The provisions hereof constitute a privacy policy (hereinafter: "Privacy Policy") which sets forth information relating to the collecting of data, including personal data of the users of websites belonging to M&MR Trading Polska Sp. z o.o. with registered office at ul. Hutnicza 25 DE, 81-061 Gdynia, NIP no.: 584-10-16-120, as well as the manner of their processing.

The processing of personal data is conducted in accordance with the Regulation of European Parliament and of the Council (EU) dated April 27, 2016 on the protection of natural persons with regard to the processing of personal data and on the free movement of such data, and repealing Directive 95/46/EC (hereinafter referred to as "GDPR" or "General Data Protection Regulation"), effective since May 25, 2018, as well as with the Act of August 29, 1997 on the protection of personal data (consolidated text: Journal of Laws of 2002, no. 101, item 926 as amended).

M&MR Trading Polska Sp. z o.o. employs various technical and organizational means for the purpose of ensuring the best practicable securing of the collected personal data from unauthorized access or improper use by unauthorized persons.

2. Personal data and authorizations of Internet users

M&MR Trading Polska Sp. z o.o. makes its best endeavours to ensure that the operated websites **www.mmr-trading.pl**, **www.transcomfort.pl**, **www.mmr-ttm.pl**, **www.konkurs.transcomfort.pl**, **www.pxp.com.pl** oraz **www.formyelastoermowe.pl** facilitate each user the browsing of the website and searching for information on the company and its offering. The company respects the users' right to privacy and applies appropriate technological solutions preventing violations of the users' privacy by third persons.

Therefore, striving for the safety and convenience of use, we hereby inform that, by using our websites, users consent to their use of cookie files and other voluntarily provided personal data by them. The data for which the user is requested, e.g. when signing up for newsletter subscription, are necessary for operating the website or providing a service. The providing of data is voluntary. Every user has the right to receive information, access their data, correct them, restrict their processing, transfer or delete them, or the right to object and to subject them to profiling.

The data are processed for the purposes described in this policy, to, among others:

- provide the given service (justified interest of the controller),
- provide you with higher security of services, including: to search for bots, swindles and abuses,

- perform measurements that enable us to improve our services.

The websites of M&MR Trading Polska Sp. z o.o. do not endorse or contain any content that contravenes with Polish and international law, incite to racial, religious or ethnic hatred, are morally offensive or popularly believed to be unethical or insulting.

3. Purposes and goal of using data

3.1. Cookies

M&MR Trading Polska Sp. z o.o. automatically collects the data included in cookie files when using Internet sites. Cookies are small text files sent from the website provider's computer that identify him in a manner necessary to perform the given operation, e.g. in the form of authentication, collection of statistical data or recording the data in contact or order forms.

Cookies are harmless to the computer or to its user and his data. In many cases, the software used for browsing Internet websites (the browser) permits the storing of cookie files on the user's end device by default. However, in the browser's settings you may change the cookies settings, particularly in such way that their automatic processing is blocked in the browser setting, or you may notify them on their placing at the user's end device each time. The detailed information on the possibility and methods of using cookies are available in the web browser's settings. The service or its individual functionalities may not operate correctly without the cookie files, however.

Cookie files are not used for identifying the user, and his identity is not determined on their basis.

M&MR Trading Polska Sp. z o.o. uses cookie files in order to:

- provide the services (justified interest of the controller), including to ensure higher security of these services (to detect bots, fraud and abuse),
- optimize the use of Internet websites (cookie files particularly allow to identify the user device and to correctly display an Internet website adapted to his individual needs);
- prepare statistics that allow to understand the way in which the Users use the websites, which further allows to improve their structure and contents.

3.2. Subscription to free newsletters

The subscribing to electronic and free newsletters belonging to M&MR Trading Polska Sp. z o.o. requires submitting your e-mail address in the respective form. The data obtained in such way are added to the websites' mailing lists.

3.3. Unannounced messages

M&MR Trading Polska Sp. z o.o. reserves the right to send unannounced messages to persons whose contact data it holds and who have consented to the Privacy Policy. M&MR Trading Polska Sp. z o.o. defines unannounced messages as information referring directly to its portals, services and products (e.g. changes, internal promotions), uncommercial letters (e.g. wishes, personal comments etc.) and commercial information (mailing, promotion, advertisement, other marketing

materials). The entities ordering commercial mailing are not authorized to access the contact data of persons placed on the address lists of M&MR Trading Polska Sp. z o.o.

3.4. Other content forms

Pop-up windows and other content forms displayed at the Internet websites belonging to M&MR Trading Polska Sp. z o.o. and concerning the services, products and portals not operated by M&MR Trading Polska Sp. z o.o. are not subject to this „Privacy Policy”.

4. Changes to Privacy Policy

M&MR Trading Polska Sp. z o.o. reserves the right to implement changes to this Privacy Policy. Every user of the Internet websites belonging to M&MR Trading Polska Sp. z o.o. is subject to the current "Privacy Policy". M&MR Trading Polska Sp. z o.o. will announce any changes to this Privacy Policy on its Internet sites.
